On January 22, 2019, ENGIE Insight Services Inc. (ENGIE Insight) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. ENGIE Insight's currently-effective registration expires on March 25, 2021.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete and the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000. Staff therefore recommends that ENGIE Insight's application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service be approved, effective as of March 25, 2019, for a term of 2 years.
