No. 26.313 Granting Petition On December 6, 2019, the Commission approved a Qualified Capital Project Adjustment Charge (QCPAC) for Pennichuck East Utility, Inc. (PEU). The Commission approved a 2.98 percent surcharge to be applied to customer bills on a service-rendered basis as of July 22, 2019. As a result, an average residential customer using 7.29 hundred cubic feet of water per month will pay \$2.25 under the QCPAC, in addition to existing monthly rates of \$75.45. The Commission also approved a twomonth recoupment charge to recover the revenues that would have been collected between July 22, 2019, and the effective date of Commission's Order. The Commission preliminarily proved a budget of \$2,058,625 for QCPAC projects proposed for construction in 2019, and accepted the estimated 2020 and 2021 QCPAC project budgets of \$2,470,580 and \$3,328,000 for informational purposes.

The Commission further granted PEU authority to include the annual interest incurred on its Fixed Asset Line of Credit in its annual long-term debt issuances, which will later be eligible for recovery through future QCPAC proceedings. Because the order permits PEU to collect charges on service-rendered basis, it modifles Order No. 26,179 (October 4, 2018) and the settlement agreement underlying that order, which permitted PEU to collect charges on a bills rendered basis. With the exception of any information for which either PEU requested or the Commission granted confidential treatment, the Order, along with the petition and other filings are posted at http://www.puc.state.n h.us/Regulatory/Docketbk/ 2019/19-035.html

The Commission delayed the effectiveness of its approval of PEU's request to ensure the public receives notice of the Commission's determination and has an opportunity to request a hearing. All persons interested in responding to the Commission's action may submit their comments or file a written request for a hearing, which states the reason and basis for a hearing, no later than December 23, 2019. Any person(s) responding to such comments and requests for hearing shall do so no later than December 30, 2019. Following consideration of any comments and request for hearing received, the Commission may further extend the final effective date of its Order. Unless the Commission orders otherwise, the

Order shall become final effective on January 6, 2020.

1. Three hearts. First, it might be best to discuss the meaning of partner's three-club bid. It is a jump shift, forcing to game, and in effect says: "Partner, I realize you may have only six points for your one-notrump response, but those six points are enough for us to make a game in some denomination."

This means, of course, that partner has upward of 19 points, most of which are in the form of high cards, but some of which are sure to be distributional. The reason for responding three hearts rather than four clubs, the suit you have slightly better support for, is that a 10-trick heart game (partner has to have at least five hearts) is more likely to make than an 11-trick game in clubs.

2. Four hearts. Having limited your hand to six to 10 points by your initial response, you can afford to jump to four

hearts without the risk of having the bid misunderstood. The nine points you have - six of which are in partner's two suits - should prove to be highly useful. The reason for jumping to four hearts rather than bidding just three is to encourage partner to consider bidding a slam if he has a hand something like: ♠ K5 ♥ AKQ72 ♠ A ♣ KJ1082, in which case slam is an excellent proposition.

3. Three notrump. That's about all you can do with this hand. The nine-trick game in notrump looks more feasible than an 11-trick game in clubs. If partner passes, you should be all right, but if he rebids hearts or clubs, you will then carry on to five clubs.

4. Five clubs. Your stock wen up considerably when partner jumped to three clubs. This assortment didn't look very imposing at the start, when game seemed doubtful, but the jump-shift has completely changed the picture.

It would be wrong to bid on four clubs, which you would also do with, say, five clubs to the queen instead of the ace. But with your actual holding, partner has to be apprised the the club raise is being given n just as a matter of obligation, but with genuine enthusiasm so that if a slam is in the offin partner will be encouraged to bid it.
