Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses

Dear Director Howland:

On March 13, 2019 Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submitted its petition for recovery of storm expenses pertaining to storm events from July 2016 through December 2017. On September 8, 2020 the Commission's Staff recommended recovery of the requested storm expenses subject to certain disallowances. On September 21, 2020, the Commission issued a secretarial letter approving the amounts specified in the Staff's recommendation. As part of its letter, the Commission also stated that "Eversource shall notify Staff when the Company has determined the amount of appropriate carrying charges, and it shall confirm the amount of the recovery and balance of the MSCR fund." September 21, 2020 Secretarial Letter at 2.

By this letter, Eversource is informing the Commission that on February 17, 2021, Eversource notified the Staff of the carrying charges and confirmed the amount of the recovery and the balance of the MSCR fund and the Staff has confirmed that the information provided fulfills the Commission's requirements. For clarity, the total amount of recovered costs is \$50,343,061 which reflects the balance of costs noted in the Commission's letter as updated with the application of the appropriate carrying charges through September 2020.
