Request to Modify Filing Date – Condition Assessment – Supplement

Dear Director Howland:

On December 15, 2020 the Commission issued Order No. 26,433 approving an October 9, 2020 Settlement Agreement (“Settlement”) in the above-captioned proceeding relating to the rate case filing of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”). Relevant to this filing, Section 11.1 of the Settlement provides that Eversource will hire an engineering firm to perform a condition assessment of the Eversource distribution infrastructure and Section 11.5 of the Settlement states that the results of the assessment will be submitted by March 31, 2021 as supplemental testimony in the docket for Eversource’s 2020 least-cost integrated resource plan filing, Docket No. DE 20-161.

Yesterday, February 4, Eversource submitted a request to modify the deadline for providing the results of the assessment based upon information received from bidders in the RFP to conduct the assessment. At the time of that filing, Eversource indicated the agreement of certain parties to the request. Since that time additional parties have indicated their agreement and Eversource is submitting this supplement to share their positions with the Commission. Accordingly, Eversource is notifying the Commission that AARP and The Way Home have both stated their agreement with the request to extend the deadline for the assessment.
