In Order No. 26,267, the Commission approved Temporary Rates designed to increase revenue by \$2,093,349 on an annual basis effective July 1, 2019. This rate change results in an increase of 1.88%, or \$2.29 for a customer taking energy service using 650 kilowatt-hours per month.

In addition, in Docket No. DE 16-383, the Company added a page to the Terms and Conditions that provided a list of holidays. In the list, the Company inadvertently added Martin Luther King Jr./Civil Rights Day to the list of holidays and this holiday is not and has never been considered a holiday for purposes of billing service in off-peak periods. The Company is filing redline and clean versions of the tariff with an Issue Date of July 8, 2019, but an Effective Date of May 1, 2017, as this change is merely a housekeeping change to the tariff and does not change billing for off-peak periods.
