Annual Reconciliation of Energy Service and Stranded Costs for 2018  
Extension of Deadline for Annual Reconciliation Filing

To the Parties:

On April 17, 2019, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) filed a request to extend the deadline for filing its annual reconciliation of energy service and stranded costs. Pursuant to Order No. 24,125 (February 14, 2003), Eversource is required to make its annual reconciliation filing on May 1 of each year. *See id.* at 12. Eversource has requested an extension of that deadline to June 1, 2019 for the purpose of this year's filing.

Eversource requested the extension because it has had a recent change in company personnel. It stated that the extension would have no impact on the information contained in its annual reconciliation filing or affect rates, as that filing is an historic review of Eversource's activities. Eversource notified Commission Staff (Staff) and the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), which filed a letter of participation in this proceeding on April 23, 2019, of its request. Staff did not object, and the OCA has not filed a response.

The Commission has reviewed Eversource's request to extend the deadline for filing its annual reconciliation of energy service and stranded costs and determined that the standards for an extension of time contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 202.04 have been satisfied. Accordingly, Eversource's request to extend deadline has been granted, so that Eversource shall file its annual reconciliation of energy service and stranded costs on or before Monday, June 3, 2019, the first business day following June 1.
