
On November 14, 2019, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule per Commission Staff request and subsequent party assent to that request in Docket No. DE 19-104, Petition for Clean Innovation Community Solar Pilot Proposal. This occurred for a number of reasons, including Order No. 26,297 and SB 165 that suspended development of low-to-moderate income pilot programs for various periods of time. For this docket specifically, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule for six months ending May 14, 2020.

Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy took into account the above developments, as well as the progress of Docket No. DRM 19-158 that undertook modifying New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Chapter Puc 900 Net Metering for Customer-Owned Renewable Energy Generation Resources of 1,000 Kilowatts or Less.

With the changes in DRM 19-158 approaching finality and the conclusion of suspension periods approaching, Eversource has updated its pre-filed testimony and its model RFP for its CICS pilot proposal, and submit both now along with a model bill impact exhibit as a means to request that Staff and the Commission take up the instant docket and resume proceedings. These submissions may serve as a way for parties (Eversource Energy, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, Clean Energy New Hampshire, Conservation Law Foundation, and Commission Staff) to this docket to refamiliarize themselves with Eversource's current position towards its development of its pilot program.

For the above reasons, Eversource respectfully requests that the Commission grant to renew the procedural schedule for DE 19-104. Thank you for your consideration in this matter. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me. Your assistance is greatly appreciated.
