I just received notice in the mail today dated 8/29/2019 regarding proposed expansion of the GST territory and have concerns regarding the increase in their service area. The time frame for providing feedback and concerns is only two business days away (9/6/19). This does not provide much time for consumers to provide feedback and notice the commission of valid concerns.

Attached is a petition from the Highland Lake Association with 102 members on Valley road in Washington and Stoddard NH that was mailed to Susan King President of GST, just today. We are specifically requesting that GST address service concerns in the area shown on the petition.

I would like to request that any final decision be delayed until our service issues in the specific area are review and a resolution has been provided.

We have also copied Senator Shaheen and the Chairman of the FCC on our petition. Please see attached.

The service bandwidth in the area is already limited and adding service to the taxed system will only create issues for homeowners already struggling with the service we are paying for.
