A report of the actual EAP administrative costs is also provided for quarter ending June 30, 2020

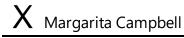
On July 3, 2020, the Program Administrator was provided customer billing and payment information via File Transfer Protocol (FTP) as required by the Procedures Manuals.
