On February 18, 2020, the Commission issued Order No.26,333, "Amended Order Approving an Amendment to the Power Purchase Agreement" (the "Order") in the abovereferenced proceeding. In the Order, the Commission required Berlin Station to provide biannual reports outlining its "progress toward achieving a permanent solution that will ensure the Excess Cumulative Reduction Amount is repaid. Copies of those reports should be provided to the standing legislative committees with jurisdiction over energy-related issues, specifically the House Science, Technology, and Energy and the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committees."
