On February 18, 2020, the Commission issued Order No.26,333, "Amended Order Approving an Amendment to the Power Purchase Agreement" (the "Order") in the above-referenced proceeding. In the Order, the Commission required Berlin Station to provide bi-annual reports outlining its "progress toward achieving a permanent solution that will ensure the Excess Cumulative Reduction Amount is repaid. Copies of those reports should be provided to the standing legislative committees with jurisdiction over energy-related issues, specifically the House Science, Technology, and Energy and the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committees."
