Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,306 (October 31, 2019) in Docket No. DG 19-145, I enclose for filing the Company's (March) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2019/2020 winter season ending April 30, 2020.

The calculation reflects the estimated February 2020 through April 2020 NYMEX settled forward prices as of February 12, 2020. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$1,980,345 is 4.32 % of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2019/2020 winter season.

Liberty elects to implement a decrease of \$0.0685 / therm for the March 1st billing cycle.


