Re: Northern Utilities, Inc. -- DG 19-154, 2019 / 2020 Annual Cost of Gas and Associated Charges Filing

Dear Director Howland,

On September 17, 2019, Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern" or the "Company") submitted its proposed 2019 / 2020 Annual Cost of Gas ("COG") Adjustment filing. In the cover letter for this filing, Northern lists the Summer Season and Winter Season bill impacts for a typical Residential customer. However, the Company has subsequently discovered an error in the language regarding the Summer Season bill impact. Specifically, the language in the cover letter states that the typical bill for a Residential heating customer for the 2020 Summer Season is projected to be \$263.95. This amount actually reflects a typical 2019 Summer Season Residential bill. For 2020, a typical Summer Season Residential bill is expected to be \$258.96. This error is limited to the Company's September 17, 2019 cover letter and is not otherwise included in the Company's filing.
