Enclosed for filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") are an original and two (2) copies of a Natural Gas Aggregator Registration Application and Attachments/Exhibits on behalf of HealthTrust Purchasing Group, Limited Partnership ("HealthTrust" or "Applicant"), pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.04(b) and (c). A check in the amount of \$250, the required filing fee, is enclosed, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05(b)(2). In addition, a PDF copy of the entire application packet (*i.e.*, this letter, the Application and Attachments/Exhibits) is being sent by e-mail to executive.director@puc.nh.gov, per the Commission's Natural Gas Registration Instructions.

Description of Applicant

Applicant is a group purchasing organization established in 1999 and headquartered in Nashville, Tennessee. HCA Healthcare, Inc. is the sole owner of the general partner of HealthTrust through indirect, wholly owned subsidiaries. HCA Healthcare, Inc. operates over 185 hospitals across the United States.

HealthTrust members are hospitals and other healthcare providers. On behalf of its members, HealthTrust negotiates the purchase of goods and services with third-party suppliers, including negotiations for the purchase of natural gas and electricity services, so that its members can benefit from their combined purchasing power. HealthTrust expects to negotiate the purchase of natural gas or electricity on behalf of its members from a third-party Commission-licensed natural gas or electric competitive supplier. Each HealthTrust member will directly purchase natural gas or electricity from the third-party licensed natural gas or electric supplier, and remit payment directly to the third-party licensed supplier. HealthTrust will not take title to

the natural gas or electricity or take responsibility for product delivery, and HealthTrust will not accept customer payments or deposits. HealthTrust will only receive an administrative fee from the third-party licensed supplier to cover the costs of conducting a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to obtain a Commission-licensed third-party natural gas or electric supplier and negotiating and administering a Group Purchasing Agreement. HealthTrust members do not pay HealthTrust any fee based on the energy purchased. HealthTrust does not charge a service fee to its members for negotiating contracts. The amount of the administrative fee is disclosed to each HealthTrust member on the natural gas Transaction Agreement between the competitive supplier, HealthTrust and the member hospital.

In compliance with N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05(a), HealthTrust will not enroll any customers or make a legally binding offer to any non-residential customers until its registration and notification process is completed. HCA Healthcare, Inc. owns two hospitals in New Hampshire, Portsmouth Regional Hospital, Portsmouth, NH, and Parkland Medical Center, Derry, NH. These two hospitals obtained natural gas service under energy contracts negotiated by their parent entity prior to 1999, and which were assigned to HealthTrust after its creation in 1999 as part of an affiliate transaction. Administrative fees associated with any energy contracts are returned to each member according to their Participation Agreement with HealthTrust.

Proposed Services

Applicant proposes to negotiate for the purchase of electricity and natural gas on behalf of its member hospitals and other healthcare providers in the State of New Hampshire from third-party competitive suppliers licensed by the Commission. Each member will directly purchase electricity or natural gas from the third-party licensed supplier, and remit payment directly to the electric or natural gas distribution company or third-party licensed supplier, as applicable. Applicant will not take title to the electricity or natural gas. The customer class to be served would be commercial and/or industrial throughout the State of New Hampshire. *No residential customers will be served*. HealthTrust will not provide services to a customer that consumes less than 50,000 kWh or 1,500 Dth per year. The customers to be served are HealthTrust members, which would be classified as either industrial or large volume commercial or commercial customers.

Applicant notes that since its inception in 1999, its membership has grown to more than 4,000 healthcare providers located in virtually every state, with an aggregate annual purchasing volume of over \$40 billion. 
