Record Request Responses

Dear Chair Goldner:

Consistent with the request of certain parties to the above-captioned proceeding, on June 3, 2022, the Commission held a pre-hearing conference intended to seek clarification of certain requirements in Order No. 26,589 (March 2, 2022). During that pre-hearing conference the Commission issued four requests for additional information. Specifically, the Commission sought:

1. A copy of the PowerPoint presentation of the data platform interface shown at the prehearing conference;
2. A summary of national and other standards for utility cybersecurity;
3. An electronic version (link) to the Dunsky Report; and
4. A list of governance council members and their qualifications.

Included with this letter are responses to the Commission's requests as compiled by participants in the docket and on the Governance Council.

Attachment 1 to this letter is a copy of the requested presentation. Attachment 2 is a summary of the relevant cybersecurity standards. Attachment 2 includes four documents – the first document, Attachment 2a, maps the proposed security controls for the New Hampshire platform to various industry standards, and the remaining documents, Attachments 2b-2d, are copies of the standards.

Regarding the third request, the parties do not have a link to the Dunksy Report to provide. The parties, however, understood the Commission's request for the electronic version to be precipitated by the obscuring or omission of certain data included in the version of the report that was provided with the pre-hearing conference memorandum on May 27, 2022. So far as the parties have been able to discern, the data errors were attributable to the conversion of the report between various file formats, and the corruption of the data during the conversions. To remedy that issue, included with this letter as Attachment 3 is a copy of the report that has not been converted between formats and which includes the relevant data. Lastly, included as Attachment 4 is information on the qualifications of the present members of the Governance Council.
