This filing is intended to replace, in its entirety, the Compliance Tariff filing made by UES on April 14, 2020 in the referenced docket. Upon filing, UES was made aware of an error in its Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts, tariff page 6. The impact was to a reference under the Tier 2 level, which should be referencing 60% of NH State Median Income rather than the previously approved level of 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines. This change has no impact on the \$/kWh amounts shown. For ease of review, UES has provided as the last page in this filing, its tariff Page 6 in redline, highlighting the changes.
