Dear Chairman Goldner:

By Order *Nisi* issued June 16, 2020 in the above-captioned matter, the Commission granted Green Mountain Power Corporation the authority to discontinue electric transmission service, and remove existing transmission facilities in Chesterfield New Hampshire. *See Green Mountain Power Corporation*, DE 20-046, Order No. 26, 365 (June 16, 2020). The Commission ordered that once pole removal is complete, Green Mountain Power Corporation is to notify the Commission of the method and date of such completion. *Id.*, p. 4. This letter constitutes such notification.

Pole removal and area restoration were completed on April 25, 2022. The wire was removed by releasing it from the New Hampshire side of the Connecticut River and reeling the wire across the river to Vermont. The two Green Mountain Power structures in New Hampshire were pulled from the ground, and the holes were backfilled with native soils. Low impact tracked-vehicles were used for access to this area which was restored to its natural state after the pole holes were backfilled.
