The Commission delayed the effectiveness of its approval to ensure that the public receives notice of the Commission's determinetion and has an opportunity to request a hearing. All persons interested in responding to the Commis-sion's action may submit their comments, or file a written request for a hearing that states the reason and basis for a hearing, no later

than July 2, 2020. Any person (s) responding to such com-ments and requests for hearing shall do so no later than July 9, 2020.
