

NOW COMES Susan S. Geiger, upon oath, being duly sworn, and states as follows:

1. I represent Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) in the above-captioned docket which involves GMP’s petition for authority to discontinue operating a transmission line located in Chesterfield, New Hampshire and terminating at a substation in Brattleboro, Vermont.

2. On June 16, 2020, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“the Commission”) issued Order No. 26, 365 in the above-captioned docket, which, *inter alia*, directed GMP to publish a copy of said Order no later than June 25, 2020 in a statewide newspaper of circulation or of circulation in those portions of the state where operations are conducted. 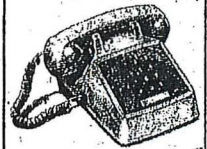
June 16, 2020

On June 16, 2020, the
Commission granted Green
Mountain Power authority
to discontinue electric
transmission service in
Chesterfield, New Hamp-
shire, and to dismantle and
remove its existing trans-
mission facilities that begin
in Chesterfield and cross
the Connecticut River to
Brattleboro, Vermont. The
petition and subsequent
docket filings, other than in-
formation for which confi-
dential treatment is request-
ed of or granted by the
Commission, are posted on

The Commission deter-
mined the public good no
longer requires service from
the transmission line be-
tween Chesterfield and
Brattleboro. The Commis-
sion authorized that service
to be discontinued, and the
poles and wires to be re-
moved.
The Commission delayed
the effectiveness of its ap-
proval to ensure that the
public receives notice of the
Commission's determina-
tion and has an opportunity
to request a hearing. All
persons interested in re-
sponding to the Commis-
sion's action may submit
their comments, or file a
written request for a hearing
that states the reason and
basis for a hearing, no later
than
July 2, 2020. Any person
(s) responding to such com-
ments and requests for
hearing shall do so no later
than July 9, 2020. Follow-
ing consideration of any
comments and requests for
hearing received, the Com-
mission may further extend
the final effective date of its
Order. Unless the Commis-
sion orders otherwise, the
Order shall become final
and effective on July 15,
2020.
