Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy—tariff compliance filing for amendment to extend repayment term for energy efficiency loans

Dear Director Howland:

Pursuant to the Commission letter issued in the instant docket on May 29th 2020, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or "Company") submits this compliance filing amending the tariff to extend the maximum possible repayment term of energy efficiency loans through on-bill financing for residential customers to 36 months, as described on the new 2nd Revised Page 96 of Eversource's tariff NH PUC No. 9.

The phrase "at the Company's discretion" has been removed, and all residential energy efficiency loan recipients that contact Eversource to defer loan payments due to financial hardship will have such requests granted. The newly modified page 096, attached to this filing, reflects the agreed upon language that was subsequently approved by the Commission. Eversource notified all existing residential energy efficiency loan recipients of this new financing option on June 11, 2020: encouraging them to contact us if they are experiencing financial hardship so that we may better accommodate their circumstances. The mailed notice together with this compliance filing completes the requirements set out by the Commission.
