Dear MS. Howland,

It has come to my attention that the Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Energy Board (EESE) is looking for the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to approve a huge increase to the proposed statewide energy efficiency plan for 2021-2023. This proposal will result in a significant increase (2.5X) to the System Benefit Charge (SBC), which is in addition to the existing SBC charge on our monthly NH utility bill.

As a result our bill will increase, but businesses and municipalities will see much more significant cost increases, at a time when most are struggling to survive.

I am asking the PUC to please temporarily suspend the proposed 3 year plan.
