I am a mother of two beautiful and innocent children whose future is in peril because of a climate crisis that accelerates with each passing day. We are a middle class family breaking our already tight budget to install solar panels and heat pumps and save up for a hybrid vehicle. Your order undermines our efforts and threatens our babies' futures. It makes an already difficult transition to clean energy so much more difficult, costly, and slow.

It is an insult to hardworking parents as well as the businesses trying to build their infrastructure and plan their investments. Businesses and consumers benefit from consistency, yet this order makes a sharp and irrational deviation from years of progress toward energy efficiency in N.H.

Rejecting the energy efficiency plan helps no one and harms many. A few dollars a month is more than a worthwhile and affordable investment that will save money and jobs while protecting the health and resiliency of our communities.

I am appalled at this short-sighted and dangerous decision, and I support any effort to overturn it.
