PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

Petition for a license to construct and maintain transmission lines over and across the Herrimack River in the Town of Hudson and City of Mashus.

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ORDER HO. 3846

WHENEAS, by petition filed Decumber 4, 1969, Public Service Company of New Hampshire seaks a license, pursuant to REA 371:17 and 20 (Supp.), to construct and maintain electric transmission likes over and across the Merrimack River in the Town of Hudson and City of Hashus; and

WHENEAS, the petitionar represents that the proposed construction will crass approximately four humadred fifty-seven (457) feet of said River at spoint approximately three thousand five hundred (3,500) feet southerly sthe Mashua Sewage Disposal Plant, and will consist of a 115 KV electric transmission line of wires and cables for the purpose of serving increased loads in the southern part of the City of Mashua, and to provide an alternate source of power for the continuity of such service; and

WHEREAS, following due notice, no other interested parties offering objection to the proposed construction, and, upon investigation and consideration, this Commission finds that the proposed construction is necessary in order to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public, and that the license sought therein may be exercised without substantially affecting the public rights in the waters crossed; it is

ORDERED, that a license be, and hereby is, granted to the Public Service Company of New Hampshire to construct and maintain electric transmission lines over and across approximately four hundred fifty-seven (457)

feet of the Merrimack River in the Town of Hudson and City of Mashua, all in accordance with a plan submitted with the petition, and on file in the office of this Commission.

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

Petition of Public Service Company of New Hampshire under RSA 371:17-20 as amended by <u>c</u>. 21, Laws of 1967, for license to construct and maintain an electric line over and across the Merrimack River in the town of Hudson and the City of Nashua, New Hampshire.

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION:

Public Service Company of New Hampshire, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of The State of New Hampshire and engaged in the generation, transmission and sale of electric energy in said State (hereinafter called the Petitioner), respectfully represents as follows:

- (1) That in order to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public it is necessary for the Petitioner to construct a 115 KV electric transmission line of wires and cables over and across the Merrimack River in the town of Hudson and the City of Nashua, New Hampshire.
- (2) That the transmission line is necessary to serve increased loads in the southern part of Nashua which are presently served at 34.5 KV and to provide an alternative source of power for continuity of service in the southern part of Nashua.
- (3) That the location of the crossing is approximately three thousand five hundred (3,500) feet southerly of the Nashua Sewage Disposal Plant as shown on a print of a U.S.G.S. map entitled "Proposed 115 KV Water Crossing Merrimack River Hudson & Nashua, N. H. December, 1969" attached hereto as Exhibit 1. The construction is as shown on a plan entitled "115 KV Line Crossing Merrimack River Hudson & Nashua, N. H." Public Service Company of

New Hampshire Engineering Department No. D-7649-77 dated 12-1-69 attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

- (4) That the lines and supporting structures on the east side of the Merrimack River will be erected and maintained by the Petitioner pursuant to easements already obtained. The lines and supporting structures on the west side will be erected and maintained on land of the Boston and Maine Corporation pursuant to a license agreement which the railroad has agreed to execute.
- (5) That the width of the river at the location of the crossing is approximately four hundred fifty-seven (457) feet.
- (6) That the Petitioner believes, and therefore avers, that the license hereby petitioned for may be exercised without substantially affecting the public rights in said waters.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner prays:


- (a) That the Commission find that the license petitioned for may be exercised without substantially affecting the public rights in the Merrimack River; and
- (b) That the Commission render judgment granting the Petitioner a license to construct and maintain said crossing.



Dear Mr. Snow:

This is to inform you that, in accordance with your recent request, Department of the Army general permit authorization No. NAE-2010-02435, which the Corps of Engineers confirmed in our letter of June 15, 2011, is hereby modified to delete Permit Special Condition No. 1 as stated in our June 15, 2011 letter and replace it with the following:

Special Condition No. 1. Wires at the aerial crossing of the Merrimack River located in the vicinity of the following New Hampshire State Plane Coordinate pair, on the 1983 North American Datum (NAD 1983), 120252.9368 N and 1034206.2354 E, at no time and under no circumstances shall be lower than the elevations specified in the following sentences. Electric power lines transmitting 115 kV and below shall be no lower than Elevation 148.91 Feet on the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD88). The corresponding elevation on the National Geodetic Vertical Datum (NGVD) is Elevation 149.6 Feet NGVD. Electric power lines transmitting 345 kV shall be no lower than Elevation 158.91 Feet NAVD88, which corresponds to Elevation 159.6 Feet NGVD. Communication and other aerial wires shall be no lower than Elevation 138.91 Feet NAVD88, which corresponds to Elevation 139.6 Feet NGVD.

All other terms and conditions of the original authorization remain in full force and effect.
