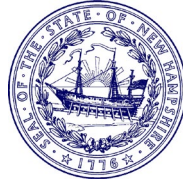

RE: DT 20-138 TDS Telecom Interconnection Agreement Between TDS Telecom and Level 3 Communications, LLC

Dear Chair Goldner:

On September 28, 2023, TDS Telecommunications LLC (TDS Telecom) and Level 3 Communications, LLC (Level 3) filed a joint request for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement between TDS Telecom and Level 3, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Section 47 USC 252(e)(2)(A) requires the Commission to approve a negotiated interconnection agreement unless it is determined that the Agreement, or some portion of it, discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or that the implementation of the Agreement would not be consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In their filing, TDS Telecom states that the interconnection agreement is the result of arms-length negotiations between the two parties, does not discriminate against any other telecommunications carrier, and is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. TDS Telecom also asserts that approval of the interconnection agreement will increase competition and is likely to benefit New Hampshire consumers. After review, Department staff found no evidence to dispute these claims. As such, the Department recommends approval of the interconnection agreement.

The Department would also note that between at least 2018 and July 2021, the Commission has approved interconnection agreements via secretarial letter rather than Order *Nisi*. The Department would support either a functional equivalent to a secretarial letter or Order *Nisi* for approval.
