NHPUC Members,

I am a resident in Hickory Woods, an over 55 community in Londonderry, NH. My position is that along with the major additional costs that we retired seniors face by living on a private road to include excessive fire hydrant rentals paid by our community HOA and not the Town of Londonderry we should not be subject to the severe increases in water rates Pennichuck is currently requesting.

In addition, since it is my understanding that Pennichuck is owned by the City of Nashua we and other municipalities are in effect subsidizing the water costs for the residents of Nashua which doesn't seem right at all. It is also my understanding that the water we get through Pennichuck comes from several wells in Hudson, NH and occasionally from the Manchester Water Company. Another example of other municipalities benefitting to our detriment. How something like this occurs in today's regulated environment is baffling. If my information is correct I think these rate increases are unjustified and I hope you would not approve them.
