Gary and Chris,

The cleaning has been going well and specific capacity of the well has been restored to original 1983 levels. The largest concern noted is that the static groundwater level is approx. 8 feet lower today than in 1983.

Surging and pumping the well will end tomorrow. Although not confirmed by Maher, we expect the pump and motor to be back on site mid-week. This may allow for chlorinating and flushing of the well and taking a sample at the end of next week.

I have not yet received a quote from Maher regarding the motor leads replacement cost. The pump was found in excellent shape.

I will keep you informed as information presents itself.
