Re: DW 20-156 – Pennichuck East Utility, Inc. Permanent Rate Proceeding Temporary Rate Compliance Tariffs

Dear Chairwoman Martin:

Pursuant to Commission Order No. 26,508 issued on August 16, 2021, attached please find Pennichuck East Utility, Inc.'s (PEU) compliance tariffs. The tariffs reflect the approved 14.03% temporary rate increase.

As part of the temporary rate settlement, PEU agreed to forego collection of its Qualified Capital Project Adjustment Charge (QCPAC). Therefore, the QCPAC tariff page has also been amended to reflect a zero QCPAC surcharge as of the date of the Commission's order. Additionally, as the Commission is aware, in Docket DW 20-019, PEU revised its QCPAC request to zero. (See Tab 17, August 17, 2021 amended petition.)

Pursuant to Puc 1603.03(a), an original and two copies are being provided to the Commission.
