Rate Case Expense-Temp-Perm Compliance Tariff Supplements

## Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's temporary filing requirements dated March 17, 2020 and Order No. 26,637, please see the attached clean and annotated compliance tariff supplements for recovery of rate case expenses and for recovery of the difference between revenues collected under temporary and permanent rates.

The annotations reflect the changes made from what was originally filed. As the Commission noted in its Order, rate case expenses were reduced by \$480. This reduced the total rate case expenses to \$117,878.69. Dividing that number by 8251 customers results in a yearly percustomer amount of \$14.29. The monthly surcharge, however, remained at \$1.19, due to rounding of the fractions of cents.

Because the rates take effect July 1, 2022, the Company asks that the Commission's review of the compliance tariffs be completed by the effective date of July 1, 2022.
