Procedural Order re: Status Update

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On January 17, 2023, the Commission issued a procedural order asking the Department of Energy ("DOE" or "the Department") and Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("PSNH" or "the Company") to file a "status update" with the Commission regarding "the likelihood of a settlement agreement being filed or updates regarding their positions or any other matters of interest." *See* Procedural Order (January 17, 2023).

In response to the Commission's request, DOE states as follows: DOE does not anticipate filing a settlement agreement in this docket. Subject to DOE's recommendation that in the next two years PSNH investigate a nonwires alternatives (NWA) threshold of \$1 million for New Hampshire project(s), and further subject to DOE's position that DOE's approval of the application of N-1 criteria for DER interconnections must be contingent upon the outcome of DOE Docket No. IP 2022-001, DOE recommends that the Commission approve PSNH's 2020 LCIRP and 2020 LCIRP Supplement as consistent with RSA 378:38 and :39 requirements. *See* RSA 378:38, :39 (and common law prior to August 8, 2022); proposed Exhibit 16 (*Revised Joint Testimony of Dudley and Willoughby* filed August 26, 2022), proposed Exhibit 17(Confidential version of Exhibit 16) and proposed Exhibit 20 (*Technical Statement of Dudley and Willoughby Regarding PSNH's 2020 LCIRP and 2020 LCIRP Supplement* filed January 17, 2023).
