In response to the Commission's January 18, 2022 Order postponing the start date of the hearing to January 25, Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF") wishes to inform the Commission that CLF's and Clean Energy NH's witness, Christopher Villarreal, is unavailable to testify on January 25.
