Please be advised that I represent the Town of Lee which received an Order from your office on March 12, 2021 concerning a petition from Eversource to amend their license and allow for replacement poles in Lee. The Order indicates that it will be effective after March 22, 2021 if no requests for a hearing and/or no public comment is received by that time.

Unfortunately, the Lee Selectboard is not meeting until March 22, 2021.
