This is a comment on Liberty's horrible request for additional gas capacity contracts for NH customers via DG 21-008.

I am dismayed by Liberty Utilities' continued focus on expanding fracked methane gas usage in New Hampshire, particularly when we are feeling the effects of climate change more every year.
