Please accept this comment on Liberty's request for additional gas capacity contracts for NH customers via DG 21-008.

I am concerned with Liberty Utilities' continued focus on expanding fracked methane gas usage in New Hampshire, particularly when we are feeling the effects of climate change more every year. New Hampshire lags behind in renewable energy use and energy efficiency in particular, and Liberty's money would be better spent making a difference on those fronts. Ratepayers are going to be paying more for energy this winter, and bringing in more fracked methane gas is not a solution that will decrease our energy bills in the long run.
