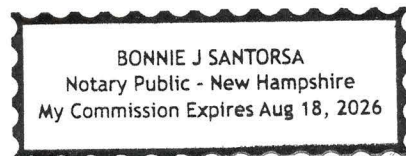

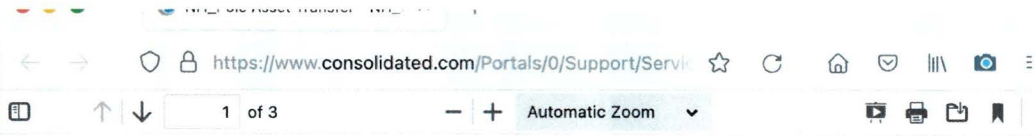

**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER OF NOTICE**

On March 18, 2021, the Commission issued an order of notice in this matter. The Commission issued a supplemental order of notice on July 29, 2021. This supplemental order of notice notifies the parties and public that the proceeding will now be in person.
