In its initial post-hearing brief filed on June 3, 2022¹ in the above-captioned docket, the New England Cable and Telecommunications Association, Inc. ("NECTA") indicated, at pages 20-21, that NECTA, on behalf of NECTA Members, had initiated the process for disputing Consolidated's pole attachment rates. It further indicated that if the parties were unable to resolve their rate dispute, a petition for resolution of the rate dispute would be filed with the Commission in accordance with N.H. Admin, R. Puc 1304.03.
