

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## **Revised Pennichuck East Utility Qualified Capital Project Adjustment Charge**

As a part of the February 2021 QCPAC filing, Pennichuck East Utility requested the PUC to allow it to bill for a QCPAC surcharge of 4.08% over and above the rates being sought in the Company's rate case filing in docket DW 20-156. The requested QCPAC surcharge will allow Pennichuck to recover the costs associated with debt financing the QCPs placed in service during 2020. The 4.08% QCPAC surcharge, if approved, will apply to all customer classes and charges for service rendered after June 30, 2021 and would be expected to go in effect near the end of 2021.
