**RE: DE 21-030, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. Attestation (Puc 1604.04)**

Dear Chairwoman Martin,

On April 2, 2021, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (“Unitil” or the “Company”) submitted rate schedules pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 1600 *et seq* in the above-referenced matter. In its cover letter to the filing, the Company noted that it was unable to contemporaneously provide a signed and notarized attestation as required by Puc 1604.04 due to restrictions related to the Covid-19 pandemic and the precautionary quarantining of certain Company personnel. Unitil therefore requested a temporary waiver of Puc 1604.04.

Unitil’s Covid-related workplace restrictions have been relaxed since the initial filing of the Company’s case, and the Company is now able to provide the required attestation. A copy of the signed and notarized attestation is provided with this letter. As the Commission’s moratorium on paper filing remains in place, Unitil will retain the original attestation in its files and provide it if and when requested by the Commission.
