Dear Ms. Howland:

This letter and attachment supplement the documents submitted to the Commission on behalf of Clearview Electric, Inc. d/b/a Clearview Energy (“Clearview”) on March 4, 2021 in the above-referenced docket.

Pursuant to a financing agreement that supports all power purchases at ISO-NE between BP Energy Company (“BP”) and Clearview, Clearview’s load assets for all New Hampshire utilities were transferred to BP on April 1, 2017. To facilitate the change in load assets from Clearview to BP, Clearview submitted Asset Relationship Change (“ARC”) forms to ISO-NE for New Hampshire’s three electric distribution utilities to facilitate the change in load assets from Clearview to BP. BP is now the primary party responsible for the settlement of all transactions at ISO-NE related to these load assets. However, as shown in the attached screenshot from ISO-NE’s participant directory, Clearview Electric, Inc. remains an active ISO-NE Market Participant (50992).

Pursuant to your letter dated March 17, 2020 indicating that the Commission has suspended its rules regarding the filing of paper copies, no such paper copies of this letter and attachment are being filed at this time.
