Streetlighting Tariff Adjustment - Supplement

Dear Director Howland:

On March 31, 2021 Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submitted a proposed revision to its streetlighting tariff to implement a new rate offering it had designated as Rate EOL-2. The testimony accompanying that filing noted that the proposed effective date for this new offering was intended to be January 1, 2022, subject to the necessary billing system changes being implemented on time. The cover letter and the tariff pages included with the March 31, 2022 filing did not include the January 1, 2022 proposed effective date.

Following the filing, the Commission Staff requested that the proposed effective date be made explicit in the cover letter and tariff pages. To align with that request, by this submission, Eversource makes clear that it is proposing a January 1, 2022 effective date for this new tariff. Also, included with this letter are revised tariff pages reflecting the January 1, 2022 proposed effective date. Eversource requests that the Commission accept this material as a supplement the material submitted on March 31, and that it be treated as part of that submission for purposes of this proceeding.
