
Procedural Order Re: Motion to Enlarge Time

The Commission issued a procedural order on December 1, 2021 in the above-captioned matter requiring the New Hampshire Department of Energy (Energy) to file an audit report or request additional time to investigate by January 11, 2022. The order also gave Energy a January 25, 2022 deadline for notifying the Commission whether the parties requested further process and/or a hearing.

On January 10, 2022, Energy filed a motion, assented to by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, requesting additional time to complete the audit report and to report whether further process and/or a hearing will be necessary. Energy stated that it anticipated its investigation would be completed by April 26, 2022, with a final report to be filed thereafter. Energy maintained that denial of its request would cause undue hardship.

Energy's motion has been GRANTED. See N.H. Admin. R., Puc 202.04. Energy shall complete its investigation and issue its final report, as well as notify the Commission whether further process and/or a hearing will be required, by Thursday, May 19, 2022. Energy should include with its final report a copy of the audit report and any other supporting documentation which will enable the Commission to assess the final report's conclusions.
