4. On October 22, 2021, a copy of the order was published on the portion of Aquarion’s site dedicated to such notices. Attached is a screenshot documenting that publication.



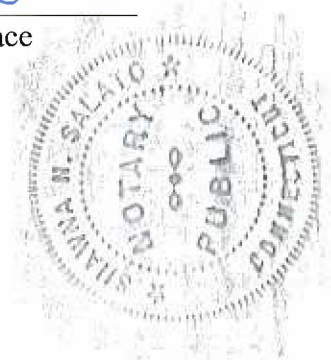
