Dear Chairwoman Martin:

On October 15, 2021, the Commission issued hearing guidelines in this proceeding and also set a hearing date of November 10, 2021 to consider Abenaki Water Company, Inc.'s acquisition by Aquarion Water, a subsidiary of Aquarion, a subsidiary of Eversource.
