**Request for Change in Rates**

**Procedural Order Re: Renewed Request for Hybrid Hearing**

On May 27, 2022, the Commission issued a procedural order denying Northern Utilities, Inc.'s (Northern) request for its witness, John Cochrane, who Northern stated was based in Boston, Massachusetts, to appear remotely at the June 7, 2022 hearing. In its order, the Commission waived the 10-day objection period under New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Puc 203.07(e). Northern filed a renewed request on May 27 for Mr. Cochrane to appear remotely at the June 7 hearing, in which Northern stated it subsequently learned that Mr. Cochrane now resides in Florida.

Based on this new information, the Commission finds that good reason has now been provided for Mr. Cochrane to appear remotely. Therefore, Northern's request for Mr. Cochrane to appear remotely at the June 7 hearing is GRANTED.
