# PENNICHUCK WATER WORKS, INC.

## ASSENTED-TO MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) hereby requests Commission approval of the below procedural schedule to govern the orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding pursuant to RSA 541-A:31. In support of this request, PWW states as follows:

- 1. On June 4, 2021, PWW filed for Commission approval a 5<sup>th</sup> special contract between PWW and Anheuser-Busch, LLC as well as for a temporary extension of the 4<sup>th</sup> special contract pending Commission review and approval of the 5<sup>th</sup> special contract.
- 2. On July 7, 2021, the Commission approved the extension of the 4<sup>th</sup> special contract until January 23, 2022.
- 3. On October 18, 2021, PWW informed the Commission that it would soon revise the special contract under consideration to include additional cost of service data. PWW made that supplemental filing on November 10, 2021.
- 4. On December 28, 2021, PWW filed an assented-to motion to further extend the 4<sup>th</sup> special contract. This request is still pending.
- 5. On February, 24, 2022, PWW again amended its filing to include updated cost of service data precipitated by the sudden, large change in water supply taken by the Town of Hudson and other changes in usage by the Town of Milford and Pennichuck East Utility, Inc.

6. The Department of Energy (Department) is a party to this proceeding and wishes to conduct discovery. To that end, PWW and the Department seek Commission approval of the following procedural schedule:

Responses to Data Requests March 24, 2022

Department Data Requests, Set 2 April 7, 2022

Responses to Data Requests April 21, 2022

Technical Session, 9 AM May 11, 2022

8. The Department assents to this motion.

- A. Approve the proposed procedural schedule; and
- B. Grant such other and further relief as may be just and reasonable.
