## Re: DG 21-130; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Winter 2021-2022 Cost of Gas — December 2021 Monthly Cost of Gas Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,541 (October 29, 2021) in Docket No. DG 21-130, I enclose for filing the Company's (December) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2021-2022 Winter season ending April 30, 2022.

The calculation reflects the estimated November 2021 through April 2022 NYMEX settled forward prices as of November 19, 2021. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$9,437,594 is 9.6% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2021-2022 winter season.

The calculated cost of gas rate is \$1.0173 per therm. The company elects to reduce the cost of gas rate effective December 1, 2021. The current and revised cost of gas rates are listed in the table below.
