Please identify the LDAC rates in effect for the Summer 2022 period in this docket. Please provide an explanation of any changes made to the LDAC from November 1, 2021 to the present. Please confirm that this COG docket does not change the LDAC.

RESPONSE:

As shown on Bates 027 of the May 20, 2022, filing, the LDAC rates that are in effect for the Summer 2022 season are \$0.1318 for residential customers and \$0.0991 for commercial customers.
