Winter 2021–2022 Cost of Gas — March 2022 Monthly COG Adjustment

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty—Keene Division (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 26,542 (October 29, 2021) in Docket No. DG 21-132, I enclose for filing the Company's (March) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2021–2022 Winter season ending April 30, 2022. The Company has marked certain third-party pricing information as confidential pursuant to Puc 201.06(a)(11). The Company is including a redlined copy of only the confidential version as the redacted version would not show redlines as the figures have been redacted.

The calculation reflects the estimated February 2022 NYMEX settled forward prices as of February 10, 2022. The resulting projected under collection of approximately \$234,495 is 13.3% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2021–2022 winter season.

Liberty elects to implement a rate increase of \$0.8342 for the March 1, 2022, billing cycle. The current Cost of Gas rates are listed in the table below.
