Dear Chairwoman Martin:

Pursuant to RSA 378:1 and RSA 378:3, attached please find Pennichuck Water Works, Inc.'s (PWW) Original Page 45A for effect November 20, 2021. The tariff page reflects a new rate for an emergency, temporary supply of water from PWW to the Merrimack Village District (MVD), both of whom are members of the New Hampshire Public Works Mutual Aid Group.

Pursuant to Puc 1603.03(a) and Puc 1603.05(b), an original and two copies are being provided to the Commission.

Contemporaneously with this tariff filing, PWW is also filing a formal petition for approval to make the proposed rate effective sooner than 30 days from the date of filing and to find that an emergency exists warranting this rate to retroactively apply back to the date MVD first took service. MVD has limited funds to pay PWW's retail rate pending the Commission's review of PWW's petition.
