Pursuant to Order No. 26,597 approving the special contract between Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) and Merrimack Village District, on January 31, 2023, PWW filed its reconciliation of the difference between what Merrimack Village District paid and what the actual cost to provide the water totaled. Thereafter, the Department of Energy audited the reconciliation. As part of that audit, PWW produced an updated reconciliation, which is attached so as to update the Commission's records.

As shown on Tab 1 of the attached Excel document, or page 1 of the attached PDF, the updated amount Merrimack Village District overpaid was \$46,881.63. Therefore, subject to the Commission's review, and per the terms of the settlement agreement, Pennichuck proposes to refund Merrimack Village District \$46,881.63.
