On October 31, 2022, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., submitted the Recoupment Calculation for the 2022 QCPAC in Docket DW 22-006, filed in accordance with Order No. 26,697, dated October 11, 2022, as amended by a procedural order issued by the Commission on October 13, 2022. The Company has not filed recoupment calculations with previous QCPAC matters; and would like guidance from the Commission as to whether or not it may proceed with assessing the surcharge and recoupment consistent with the compliance tariff approved on November 17, 2022. The Company respectfully requests whether the Commission requires any additional information or if the Company can proceed with collection of the recoupment charge.
